


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
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
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
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Directions

Color the picture of the Earth. Cut it out and glue it on a paper plate.

Using the images on pages 5–7, discuss ways that you can save the Earth – recycle, plant trees, etc.

You can use the blank circles on page 8 to draw other ideas you think of.

Using the lined circles on pages 5-8, write down your ideas. Younger students can dictate their thoughts to an older student or teacher/parent.

Cut out all of the circles you will attach to the mobile.

Glue the lined pages to the back of the corresponding image.

Use a hole punch to punch holes in the top of the small circles and along the bottom of the paper plate.

Using yarn, string, or linked paper clips, attach each smaller circle to the paper plate.

Hang your mobile in a place where you will see it and be inspired to Save the Planet!
